Getting to Chamonix & Argentière

By air

Easyjet and other airlines fly to Geneva from various UK airports. There are several companies offering minibus transfers from the airport to the Chamonix valley – we have found [Mountain Drop-offs](#) to be reliable and good value. If you are a group of three or four or more, you may find it more cost effective to hire a car for your stay.

By car

The drive from Calais takes around 8 hours plus stops, and autoroute tolls are around 120€ each way.
